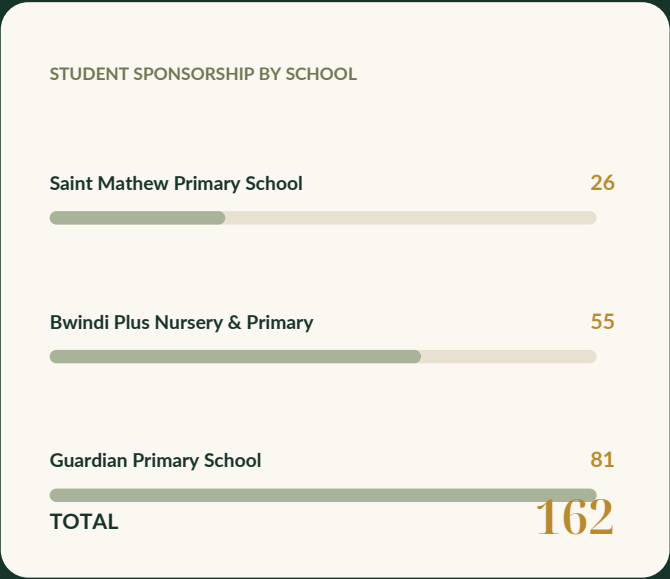

A VISIBLE MILESTONE IN BWINDI

Sail Adventure Safaris has reported contributing US\$20,000 to the ongoing Batwa Clinic project in the Bwindi region. The photographs above document visible progress as the building advances from exposed brickwork and timber scaffolding to roofing, rendered structural frames and increasingly defined spaces.

For Batwa families living around Bwindi, limited access to dependable healthcare can deepen existing vulnerability. The clinic represents an investment in dignity: a permanent, community-based facility intended to bring essential care closer to the people it is being built to serve.

This contribution forms part of Sail's wider relationship with the Batwa Empowerment Village, our primary beneficiary non-profit partner in the region. The partnership connects healthcare access with cultural dignity, community stability and practical pathways towards greater resilience.

Construction remains ongoing. The building is not presented as complete or operational. These images record the project taking shape over time, and future milestones will be reported as verified updates become available.

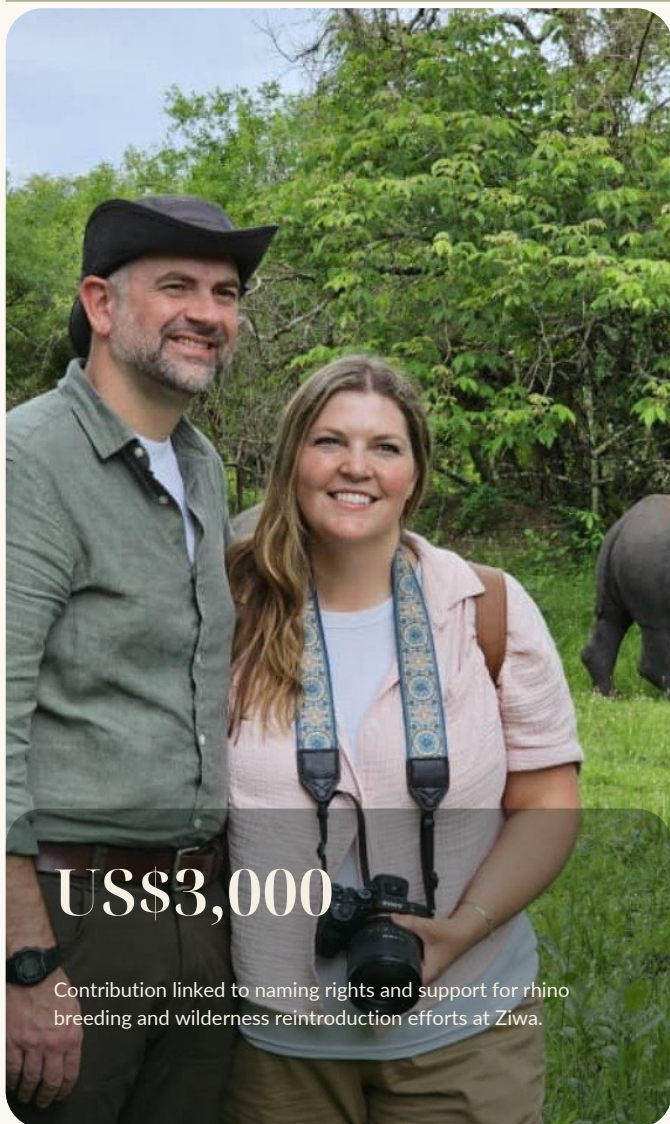

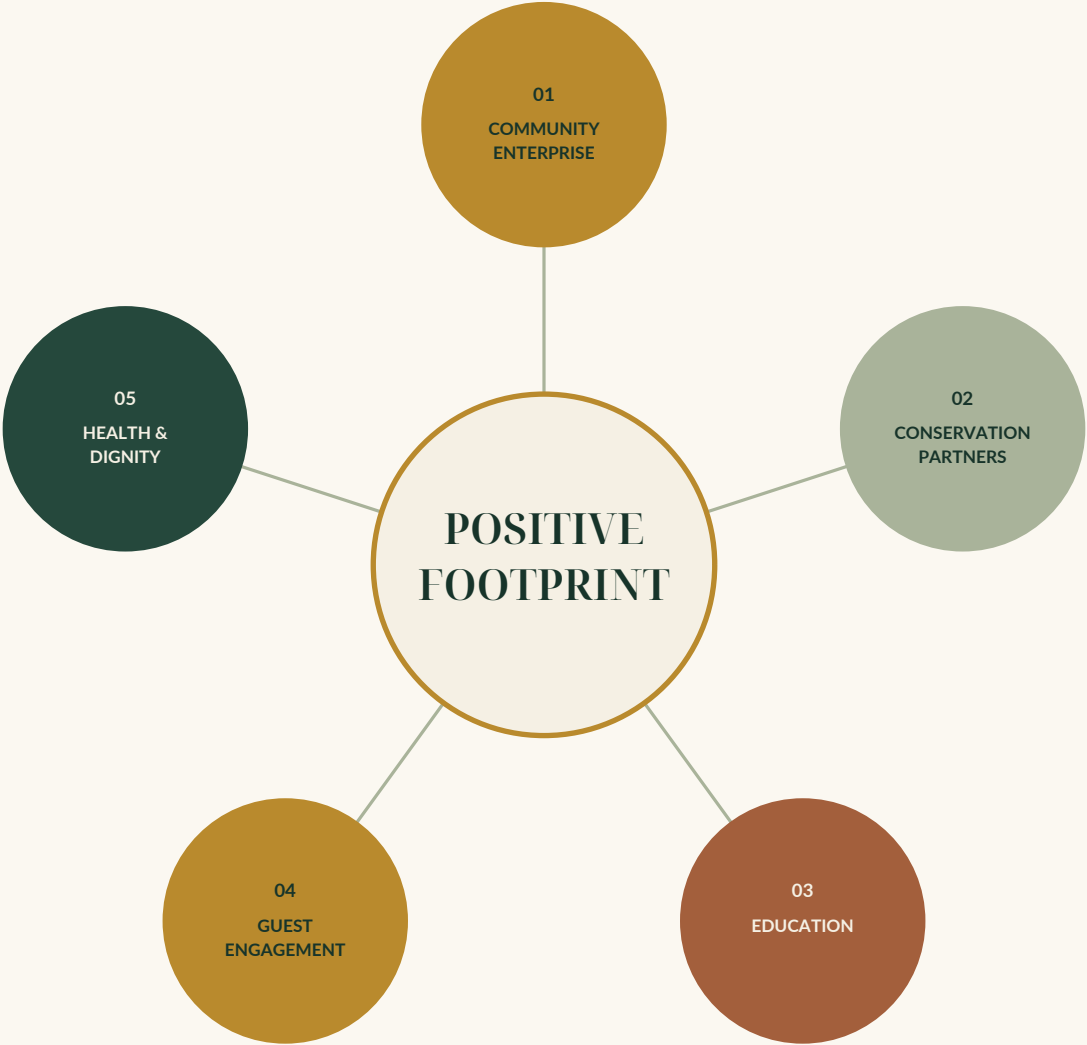
